PIGS can't sweat, so they like to keep cool by bathing in water or mud.



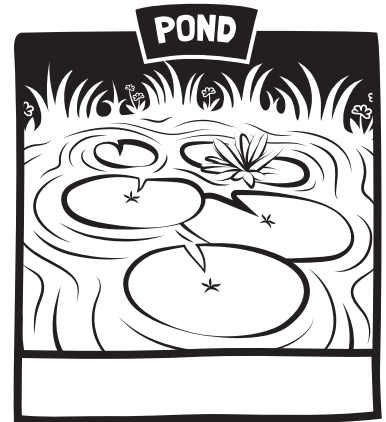
Many **FROGS** love to swim and spend most of their lives in the water.
